



High School Scholarship Policy

Parents of students in grades 8-12 can apply for two different types of financial aid for Arizona Youth Camp, which was previously known as Winter Camp, and Servant Leadership Trip. The two different types of financial aid are the Service Discount and the Needs-Based Scholarship. Please note, in order to qualify for the Needs-Based Scholarship, it is encouraged for a student to first qualify for the Service Discount and then apply for the Needs-Based Scholarship.

High School Service Discount

Students in grades 8th-12th can earn a discount for AYC and SLT. There are 25 High School sports available with awards in the amount of \$200. *Acceptance will be communicated from January 1-15th, 2018.*

Eligible students must meet **BOTH** of the following criteria from August 2018 to December 2018 to receive the discount for both AYC and SLT:

- A. Regular participation in Student Union's Services and Service Teams
 - a. "Regular participation" is defined as a student has attended one out of every two gatherings (50%). Attendance is recorded by check-in stations. It is the student's responsibility to always check in to receive credit for their participation.
- B. Serving on a Service Team
 - a. Students serve regularly on one of the following teams: Worship Team, Ministry Team, Perk Team, Community Outreach Team, or Events Team. Involvement in these teams means the student is both serving as scheduled by their assigned group leader and attending the team meetings at their designated time at the attendance ratio as marked above.
