Determine if you are in a high-risk group.

If you have underlying health conditions or are 65 or older, we encourage you to continue worshipping with us online at mountainpark.org/online.



Auditorium capacity.

Select your desired service time. No reservation needed for the auditorium. To ensure physical distancing seating is limited. Our peak service time is indicated in summer yellow. Masks are still required per state and local laws while worshipping with us..



Bring a mask and hand sanitizer.

It is required by state and local law to wear a mask while onsite. Hand sanitizer stations will be provided for you if you do not have your own.



Bring a Bible, pen, and bottled water.

Pens have been removed from the auditorium seat backs and water fountains are unavailable.



Adjust auditorium seating.

Our auditorium has been adjusted to enable appropriate physical distancing. Rows of seats are blocked off.



Enable physical distancing.

We will take measures to encourage and maintain physical distancing. Look for any directions given when you arrive.



Pray for those who will gather onsite.

We will pray for those gathering onsite and online. We'll ask God to speak clearly to you as you worship him through music, prayer, giving, and the studying of his Word.

Practice physical distancing.

We know you want to greet people, but please avoid handshakes and hugs and maintain a 6-foot distance from others. Be sure to wave and smile with your eyes!



Wear a mask.

Masks are required while onsite based on state and local law.



Find a place to sit.

Seating is general admission. Please leave at least two seats between you and others nearby.



Provide masks and hand sanitizer stations.

We have a limited supply of masks available for those unable to provide their own. Hand sanitizer stations are accessible throughout the building.



Provide touchless ways to give.

Kids and students.

Kids Ministry is available during our 9:00 and 10:30 AM services. Due to limited capacity registration is required. Please register kids at mountainpark.org/event.

Students are encouraged to worship inside the auditorium during our 9:00 AM service. During our 10:30 AM service students are invited to participate in SU Groups.
